



WHAT TO BRING to DISCOVERY CAMP

- Campers will be outside most of the time and should bring rugged clothes that can get dirty.
- Please label items with child's name.

- sleeping bag
- pillow & pillow case
- 2 towels and washcloths
- soap, comb/brush, toothbrush/toothpaste, etc.
- 2 pairs of long pants
- 1 pair of shorts FOR EACH DAY
- swim suit
- 1 shirt or t-shirt FOR EACH DAY, plus 2 extra
- 1 sweater or sweatshirt
- jacket
- brimmed hat (for sun protection)
- at least 1 pair of socks FOR EACH DAY, plus 2 extra pairs
- 1 pair of pajamas
- at least 1 pair of underwear FOR EACH DAY, plus 2 extra pairs
- tennis shoes
- 1 pair of comfortable sturdy shoes or boots for hiking (well broken in)
- old tennis shoes for stream wading and swimming (NOT sandals such as Crocs, Tevas, Flip Flops, or Chacos. If you want to swim, you must bring shoes for the water.)
- 1 flashlight with good batteries
- notebook with pencil/pen
- 1 daypack/knapsack (Please avoid backpacks with rope or string for shoulder straps, as this can be painful for campers on All Day Hikes)
- 1 canteen or water bottle with tight-fitting lid
- WATERPROOF RAINGEAR IS A MUST!

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- sunglasses and sun protection lotion
- laundry bag + garbage bag for wet items

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- reading materials (highly encouraged)
- playing cards
- pre-stamped envelopes (for writing home)
- camera
- slippers for use in lodge
- magnifying glass, binoculars, etc.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Snacks, food, candy, gum (these attract insects and rodents into the Dorm!)
- iPods, cell phones, Gameboys, radios, CD players, hair dryers, curling irons or any other electrical equipment

Also do NOT bring

- Crocs, Texas, Chacos, etc. (Open-toed footwear such as these have been known to cause ankle injuries and open wounds. River shoes only may be worn during water activities.)
- Money (Gift shop items will be for sale on the first and last days of camp.) T-shirts may also be ordered in advance.
- Knives of any kind

PLEASE NOTE: Cell phones are NOT permitted at camp. If you normally depend on one for its camera capabilities, we suggest that you instead bring a digital or disposable camera.

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
