



Great Smoky Mountains National Park Scavenger Hunt *March 25, 2017* Rules & Regulations



All rules listed below must be strictly adhered to. Any team deviating from any of these rules will be immediately disqualified from the Scavenger Hunt. Please make sure that you fully understand these rules before submitting your entry. If you have any questions regarding the Scavenger Hunt, please contact Tremont at mail@gsmnit.org or 865-448-6709.

1. Each team must submit their registration form and their entry fee to Tremont before Thursday, March 23rd at 4 p.m. \$50 per team of up to 5 people. Or \$60 per team of up to 5 people for Friday and Saturday registration. Each additional member is \$10. There are no refunds for scavenger hunt registrations at any time.
2. Your entire team must stay together during the hunt. No divide and conquer!
3. **Tremont must receive a signed event waiver for every member of your team before 3 p.m. on March 23rd, or we will not email you the hunt questions and will consider your team not participating. You can mail, fax, email or drop off these waivers to our office any time before March 23rd at 3 p.m..**
4. Hunt questions will be emailed in PDF format. Please make sure you download the latest version of Adobe Reader so that you are able to open the file.
5. All children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Youths ages 16 and 17 may enter the Scavenger Hunt without an adult, but they must have written permission from their parents before they can begin the Hunt.
6. Tremont will send each team captain an e-mail confirming that the entry fee and information has been received.
7. All individuals must obey local, state, federal and GSMNP rules and regulations at all times.
8. Only official trails and sanctioned locations will be used. Please stay on trail!
9. No items will be cached in any part of the park EXCEPT on the Tremont campus.
10. No questions or tasks require participants to gather materials from the park or make a destructive impact on park resources in any way.
11. Any team that fails to check in by the March 25th 4:30 p.m. cut off time will have 20 points deducted from their score for every minute they are late.
12. Teams are allowed to use one digital camera that uses a single removable memory flash card. No cell phone or non-flash memory card type cameras may be used. Tremont will not provide the camera. Memory card should be blank except for Scavenger Hunt pictures to help facilitate the grading. **20 points will be deducted from the team score for cards that are not blank.**
13. The above stated flash card must be turned in along with your score sheet by 4:30 p.m. on March 25th to be judged. These memory cards will be returned to the players after the judging is concluded.
14. All photos taken during the event become the property of Tremont.
15. There is no mandatory check-in at Tremont, but we will be available beginning at 8 a.m. March 25th at the Tremont Visitor Center.
16. Above all other rules listed above, please do not interfere with any other park guests. Treat others as you wish to be treated.
