

WHAT TO BRING to DISCOVERY CAMP

Campers will be outside most of the time and should bring comfortable, sturdy clothes that can get dirty. Please label items with your camper's name. Note that <u>cell phones</u> are NOT permitted at camp. If you normally depend on one for its camera capabilities, we suggest that you instead bring a digital or disposable camera.

DO BRING TO CAMP

- Sleeping bag or sheets and a blanket
- Pillow & pillow case
- Towel and washcloth for showering
- Towel for swimming
- Personal hygiene needs: Soap, comb/brush, toothbrush/toothpaste, deodorant, etc.
- Face masks: One FOR EACH DAY plus two extras
- Hand sanitizer
- 2 pairs of long pants
- 1 pair of shorts FOR EACH DAY
- Swim suit
- 1 comfortable shirt FOR EACH DAY, plus 2 extra
- 1 sweater or sweatshirt
- Rain jacket or poncho
- Brimmed hat for sun protection
- At least 1 pair of socks FOR EACH DAY, plus 2 extra pairs
- Pair of pajamas
- At least 1 pair of underwear FOR EACH DAY, plus 2 extra pairs
- Water shoes: Any closed-toed shoe with a heel strap that can be worn in the water (ex. Keens, old tennis shoes; NOT sandals such as Crocs or Chacos)
- 1 pair tennis shoes
- 1 pair of comfortable sturdy shoes or boots for hiking
- Flashlight with fresh batteries (extra batteries recommended)
- Notebook or sketch pad with pencil/pen
- 1 daypack/backpack (drawstring bags not recommended)
- 1-2 water bottles with tight-fitting lids
- Sunscreen and sunglasses
- Laundry bag + garbage bag for dirty and wet items

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Quiet activities for downtime: Reading materials, playing cards, letter-writing materials (including pre-stamped envelopes)
- Camera (phone cameras not allowed)
- Slippers or flip flops for the dorm
- Field study materials: Magnifying glass, binoculars, field guides, etc.

DO NOT BRING TO CAMP

- Snacks, food, candy, gum (these attract insects and rodents to the dorm!)
- Electronics: iPods, cell phones, video games, hair dryers, etc. (digital cameras allowed)
- Open-toed water shoes like Crocs, Tevas, Chacos, etc.
- Money (Gift shop items will be for sale during check-in and pick-up only)
- Knives of any kind
- Drones (not permitted in national parks)
