This hike will include two separate hiking groups: a 'Moderate' group that will hike all the way to the falls (7.5 miles roundtrip), and an 'Easy' group that will turn back roughly 2 miles into the hike (4 miles roundtrip). This 'out-and-back' hike follows a beautiful mountain creek the entire way on Middle Prong Trail, which is relatively level. Requires driving three miles to the trailhead.

Construct emergency survival shelters, split wood, build a fire, play the Camouflage game, and more! These activities will take place close to campus and will include no more than one optional mile of hiking. As time allows, there will also be a craft project led by park ranger Natrieifia Miller.

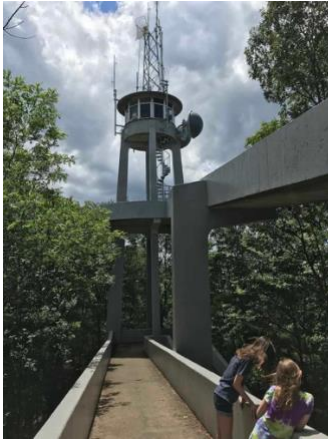
10:00 Final Remarks & Group Departure for Look Rock Observation Tower

Our final activity will be a group hike to an observation tower that offers spectacular and near panoramic views (weather permitting). The drive is just 10 miles out of the way on your drive home on Rt. 321 (Lamar Alexander Parkway). The hike is 0.8 miles long on an easy-to-follow path (1.6 roundtrip).
